

# NUCS NEW FOR 2024

---

## Contestants:

1. When entering an event, you must give the last 4 numbers of the dog or dogs NKC registration number. If you do not have the dog registered with the NKC, you will not be allowed to run that dog in any NUCS events until that dog is registered.
2. You can register your dog at the event; however, it must be done before the event begins.
3. You must be a current member of NUCS, and in good standing with NKC/NUCS

## Open Dogs:

1. In Both Open Flushing and Pointing there will be no flank collars allowed, neck only.
2. Amateur dogs will be allowed to use flank collars as long as not abused.

## Event Holders:

1. When event results are sent in to the NKC office the last 4 number of the dog registration number and full dog's name must be on the result sheet. IF this is not on the sheet the dog will not get credit for the run. If you have a dog register at the event that paper must be sent in with the fee along with the results. The NKC will issue the number once received
2. A reminder there will be no entries taken once the event has begun.
